- You need to choose a team leader to be the group's main point of contact and have them fill out the form.
- You can come back and edit details on the form as needed up until the close date.
- Any changes after that can be emailed to the Events Team prior to the withdrawal deadline.

## Equipment

JTPM is not responsible for sourcing lab equipment for students.

It is your responsibility to organise what is required for your exhibit.

JTPM will compile the responses from the registration form once it closes and pass it to coordinators.



### Risk Management

Risk Management is a key factor in the event planning process and this semester, students are required to submit an exhibition specific risk assessment to the event team.

#### **Students need to consider:**

- Moving any equipment to and from the exhibition
- Data and privacy risks, particularly IT engineering (i.e. how are they capturing and managing the public's data)
- Public interaction with their exhibit
- Management of chemicals, moving parts, heavy objects, etc. in an exhibition setting
- Power requirements
- Slip, trip and fall hazards

### Awards and Prizes

#### **Best Project in each Discipline:**

\$2,000 for winners, \$1000 for runners up

### **Sponsored Awards:**

Telstra: 2 awards, \$10,000 in prize money

Boeing: 1 award, \$5,000 in prize money

### People's Choice:

\$2,000 for winner, \$1000 for runner up
